Computer games are very complex and varied – each one adopts a different structure, different forms and their own specific language known to those who play them. Learning how they are structured is the way to win the game.

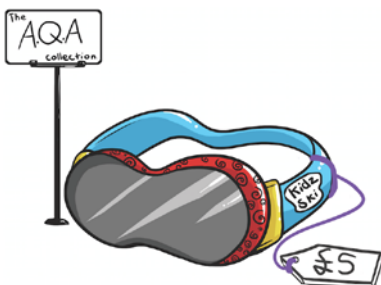


### **A03**
