

### KS3 Maths Revision

End of year assessments in Maths for Key Stage 3 students covers all the work done in class throughout the year. The assessment will therefore cover the following topics

- a) Number
- b) Shape
- c) Algebra
- d) Data.

Students will be allowed to take their current books home the weekend before the assessment plus any completed books. However, some teachers have allowed students to take completed books home once they are marked up to date.

In addition students will be able to access the [mymaths.co.uk](http://mymaths.co.uk) website which they can use to help them revise. The main log-in is

Username :- haven

Password :- percentage

This website is clearly set out and students can access any of the exercises to help them with revision. All students know their current level in maths and their target level, so they should look for exercises to complete that match these. Teachers may set specific tasks, if they do this the student should know what their own personal log-in is and the details of the tasks will be on Show My Homework. However, they **do not** need to know their log-in to access any of the exercises on the website. In addition students also have access to SAM learning which has revision material for all subjects including Maths.

The class teacher will give the students some indication as to what the tests will cover but this will only be an overview. However, students should be aware of areas of weakness from previous assessments and have their own list of topics they need to revise.
