Things you can revise:

Volcanoes and earthquakes – plate boundaries (margins), the parts of a volcano, effects of a volcano or earthquake.

Weather and climate – climate graphs, factors that influence climate.

Population – key word definitions, migration.

Settlement – settlement growth, urban models.

For 4 mark questions you may be expected to name a place and use connectives in your answers for 3 to 4 marks. This is similar to how they would mark your answers at GCSE.

Definitions

Description: Give the main features of something or an account in words of an event, a pattern or a process.

Explain: Give reasons why something happens.
