

## Year 8 History

Things you can revise:

**The Agricultural and Industrial revolutions**- how did farming and industry change in the 1700 and 1800s? What impact did industrialisation have on people's working lives and their living conditions? What was it like to be a child in Victorian Britain?

**World War One**- what were the long-term and short-term causes of World War One? Which countries fought, or helped, one another? What was trench warfare? Who won the war and how were the defeated countries treated?

**Germany after World War One and the rise of the Nazis**- how did the Germans feel towards the Treaty of Versailles? How were the Nazis able to gain power in Germany in 1933? What was it like living in Nazi Germany for different groups of people? What happened at the Concentration Camps?

**You will need to describe in detail and use sources for a level 4. For a level 5 you will need to explain your answers, begin to evaluate the usefulness of sources and suggest reasons why people interpret the past differently.**

### Definitions

Description: Give the main features of something or an account of an event, a person or place.

Explain: Give reasons for why something happened.
