University Sport Centre





SELECTION DAY

Selection is a two-way process which provides you with the opportunity to find out how you can start a fantastic training year with us. A typical day involves:

- A personal welcome and an introduction to the programme
- Formal Interview (30 mins)
- Short presentation to a group of pupils
- Written task

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- GCSE C or above* in Maths, English and Science (for Primary)
- UK Honours Degree*
- Successful completion of the **Professional Skills Test** in Literacy & Numeracy
- School experience - we recommend you arrange time in school before an application

* or equivalent

FINANCE

- We offer fee-paying and salaried places in various phases
- The cost of the course is £9,000
- Student loans for tuition fees and maintenance loans are available*
- Bursaries are available depending on teaching subject and degree class*

* Subject to eligibility - Students are responsible for their travel, accommodation and general living costs.
