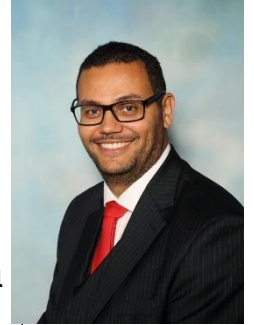

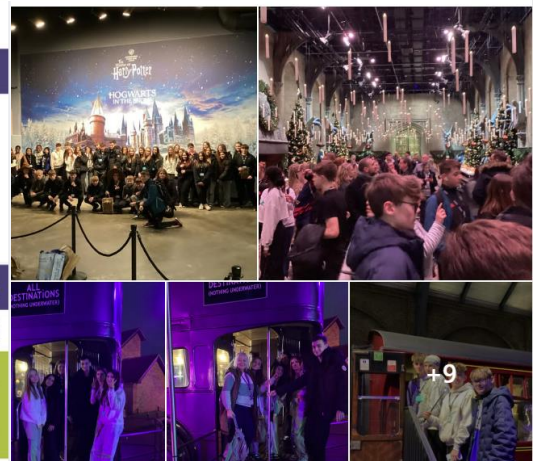

ATTENDING EVERY SCHOOL DAY MATTERS

Thank you to all our parents and families in ensuring that your child's education remains a priority and knowing that attending school everyday matters.

We know it can be very upsetting for a child who has fallen out with their friends, and they are worried that people might be unkind to them. But staying off school when this happens will not solve any problem, in fact avoiding dealing with the issue can make things worse.

PASTORAL SUPPORT WITH THE YEAR GROUP TEAMS

If your child is facing a barrier to attending like this, call 01205 311979 and ask to be put through to your Year Group Team. We have a large team of pastoral staff who are there to support. We can help, just tell us what is happening.



A medical appointment

Try to arrange appointments outside of school. If this isn't possible please provide proof of the appointment.



A temperature

Take paracetamol. They can come back in as soon as they feel better.



Your child feels tired.

They need to have an earlier bedtime so that it's easier to get up in the morning.



Your child is physically sick, has diarrhoea or a rash.

If these continue more than a few days, contact your doctor



Your child has fallen out with friends or is worried about potential bullying.

They need to talk to us to help solve the problem instead of avoiding it.



A headache or a cold

Drink plenty of fluids. Make sure they have a drink to bring with them and take painkillers before school.
