Dear Parent(s),

I am writing to inform you that Haven High will be subject to a monitoring visit from Ofsted during the next two days, Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> September and Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> September. This presents the Academy with an excellent opportunity to demonstrate the progress that we have made since the previous inspection in summer 2024. Whilst this is not a full graded inspection, it does present an opportunity to show progress. This includes our improvements in attendance (up 3.1%), attainment (2% in E&M 4+), behaviour and personal development opportunities. Whilst we recognise that we still have things to work on, I hope you agree that things are improving. Securing a positive outcome during this visit will only help us to improve the Academy further in the future.

The team from Ofsted will be made up of a team of 5 inspectors who will conduct a range of activities in lessons and around the Academy. This will include visiting lessons, observing break and lunchtime and talking to groups of students. The outcome of this monitoring visit will be a letter that outlines where we have made progress and where we still need to make further improvement.

It would be a huge support if parents can help to ensure that all our students:

- arrive at the academy on time, by 8:40am, ready for lessons to start at 8:45am
- are dressed in full and correct uniform
- have their correct equipment (pens, pencil, rubber and ruler)
