



Sports Faculty

All students take part in Physical Education as part of their core curriculum throughout their time in the Academy. It is important that each student shows good standards in work, effort and behaviour in every lesson. Students will take part in 2 x lessons every week. The curriculum sports will change each ½ term with students experiencing a range of team and individual sports. Our sport choices work alongside the seasons and the national, local leagues in which we take part in.

PE Kit

- Plain black shorts or black tracksuit bottoms. (Sports leggings are allowed but they must not be of a 'see-through' material).
- Haven High logo red coloured t-shirt
- Haven High logo red coloured jumper
- Plain black football socks (for outdoor wear)
- Sports trainers (non-marking sole) —no plimsolls, converse or vans type trainers.
- Football boots - strongly recommended for use during specific activities such as Rugby and Football. Football boots should be plastic moulds or blades – no metal studs.
- Students may also bring extra items of clothing to wear underneath their PE kit during the cold weather terms, e.g. t-shirts, vests or other base layer items, these items need to be black.

Forgotten PE kit

If a student forgets their PE kit then they will be expected to wear spare available PE kit (this is routinely washed).

The behaviour policy will be followed if a student forgets their PE kit:

- **Choice** – is given if a student has forgotten PE kit and needs to borrow the school PE kit.
- **Consequence** – is given if a student refuses to get changed into borrowed school PE kit. This will result in an escalation to a further sanction.

Faculty Rules

- Students who are not able to participate in the practical aspect of a lesson must have a note signed by parents/carers. Non partaking students must still bring their PE kit and will be expected to change for the lesson so that they can act as a leader/peer assessor/referee, unless the medical condition prevents this.
- If a student brings three consecutive notes exempting them from their PE lessons, a doctor's note may be requested. Exemption will be made for students with ongoing medical issues, appointment letters may be requested for record purposes.
- When the weather is deemed unsuitable, coats for non-participating students may be worn, at the discretion of the PE staff in-charge of the lesson. Jackets are not to be worn by students practically taking part in PE.
- Students who have forgotten their PE kit, will be expected to borrow school PE kit for their lesson.
- No jewellery, watches or bracelets should be worn in lessons.
- Long hair must be tied back for all PE lessons.
