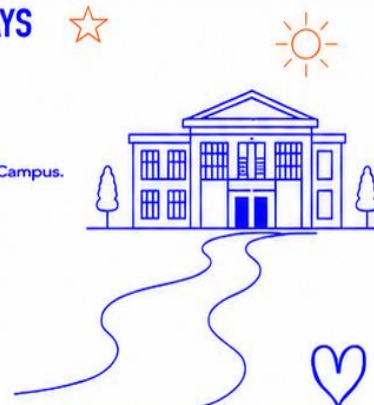

WALK TO SCHOOL



Walking is healthy, free and good for the environment.

Approximate walking times:

- 5 mins from Spilsby Road
- 10 mins from Holy Trinity Church
- 15-20 mins from Boston Town Centre (Wide Bargate)

USE CROSSINGS | LOOK BOTH WAYS | STAY ALERT



CYCLE TO SCHOOL



Cycling is quick, healthy and good for the planet.

- Wear a helmet
- Use lights in poor visibility
- Use cycle lanes where available
- Lock your bike securely in the school bike compound



TRAVEL BY BUS



- Several bus routes stop near the school.
- Check timetables before you travel
- Arrive at your stop a few minutes early
- Carry your pass or fare
- Follow the driver's instructions
- Be respectful to others



TRAVELLING BY CAR

- If you are being dropped off:
 - Use safe, legal drop-off points away from the school entrance
 - Do not block driveways or junctions
 - Follow local parking restrictions
 - Allow extra time during busy periods
