A warm welcome to Ms **Rezanova** and Miss **Pollard**, who join us for this term's newsletter! Ms Rezanova is already well known to us all, but please do make time to welcome Miss Pollard, who, to my great delight, is an **Expressive Arts specialist**.

It's been a fantastic start to the year for the Arts Faculty. Year 10 have hit the ground running across Art, Drama and Photography, with some really promising work already emerging. We're also looking forward to a faculty trip to the theatre in the coming weeks to see **Blood Brothers**.

In Drama, Year 8 students are exploring non-naturalistic theatre through the story of a character called Sam, developing their understanding of performance styles that move beyond realism. Meanwhile, Year 9 students are being introduced to the influential theatre practitioner Stanislavski, learning key techniques to help them create believable and engaging characters on stage.

At Tollfield, our students are also making a fantastic start in **Music**. Year 7 are developing their musical skills and confidence through practical lessons, enjoying opportunities to perform, compose and explore a range of musical styles.

We have also loved getting to know the talented Year 8 students who have joined us at Tollfield. Their creativity has already made a real impression in lessons, particularly while tackling the technically challenging topic of Islamic Art.

Down at Tollfield, the new intake are learning the basics of colour theory, and my classes are progressing so quickly and producing such high-quality work that I'm struggling to keep up with their output!

We continue to run **Homework Clubs** after school on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. While these are aimed primarily at GCSE students, everyone is welcome.

And finally, does anyone have any good-quality colour **magazines** they no longer need? We run a number of collage projects throughout the year and are always grateful for donations of high-quality printed images. Any donations would be very much appreciated.

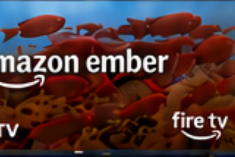
